[Statement]

I work in the fields of contemporary art and ambient music.

In my art production, I use a variety of techniques, including video, photography, sound, computer programme, text, drawing, light, sculpture and installation. I mainly research and delve into several things and places, deconstructing them by connecting seemingly unrelated elements in parallel and converging them into a single theme. In recent years, I have also been pursuing a spectacular exhibition method in which the elements of each work transcend time periods, genres and forms of expression to create a literary expansion.

More recently, I have conceived and produced a new form of archive in which site-specific works, once exhibited, are reconstituted in a variable and recycled manner according to the scale of the various spaces. This was initiated from the recognition that conventional archives such as simple video and documents are not sufficient for site-specific works that incorporate elements of place or works that allow the viewer to experience the space itself, such as installations, with the aim of extending the archive.

In sound production, I pursue an organic sound with a Japanese serenity, based on the recognition that ambient music is a rare musical genre suited to the current flattening of the world situation. Particularly in recent years, I have been interested in the informational richness of natural time and sound itself, rather than in high-resolution, noiseless digital sound.
